To create youth-centered empowering environment for enabling **young people to undergo Work Based Learning (WBL) mobility pathways.**

The project seeks to build a bridge between education and labor market sectors, contributing to the creation of long term multi-level cross-sectorial networking and cooperation.

PROJECT AIM

To provide expertise in terms of creation of empowering environment for WBL, in view of offering more international mobility learning opportunities for youth.

The project seeks to achieve a long term impact in securing positive future working perspectives for them.

OBJECTIVES

To build up competences of youth workers for becoming leaders of WBL empowering environment by creating strategies that promote such mobilities as a complementary educational paths

To provide youth organizations with guidance and tools for the creation of empowering setting for work based learning

To foster cooperation, exchange of knowledge and capacity development in the field of work based learning between the partner countries

To create conditions for cross-sectorial networking on EU level, thus set up a space for bridging the educational and labor market sectors

To encourage learning through other than formal educational means

To foster direct involvement in practical assignments so as to set up a favouring environment for enhancing youth employability in Europe

MAIN ACTIVITIES

2 international seminars aiming at transfer of knowledge, exchange of expertise and best practices among staff members of partner organizations from 8 EU countries

3 transnational project meetings among staff members, in view of producing tangible outputs

Several local meetings with educational representatives and with youth in view of their further involvement in the project

Preparation and release of **1 handbook** with guidelines and examples of best practices on how to create WBL empowering environment

Development of **1 international cooperative network** among stakeholders willing to engage for support youth employability through WBL and apprenticeships mobility schemes

Development of **Webpage and visibility materials**

Dissemination activities, online campaigning actions, etc.
